

Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements 2022-2023

Students at Schoolcraft can transfer to an MTA-receiving four-year college or university, and satisfy their lower level general education requirements by completing the MTA endorsement. To complete the endorsement, students must follow the course requirements below, and complete all classes with a 2.0 or higher.

What are the Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements?

Humanities	4	Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines
Social Sciences	6	Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines
Natural Sciences	5	Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines
Mathematics	4	Select one mathematics course from the following categories: College Algebra, Quantitative Reasoning, or Advanced Level Mathematics
Minimum Total for MTA Credit Hours	30
