## Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements 2023-2024

Students at Schoolcraft can transfer to an MTA-receiving four-year college or university, and satisfy their lower level general education requirements by completing MTA. The course requirements below must be completed with a 2.0 or higher, and at least 1 credit of MTAcoursework must be completed at Schoolcraft for the College to grant the endorsement. Occupational courses do not qualify.
