

Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements 2024-2025

Students at Schoolcraft can transfer to an MTA-receiving four-year college or university, and satisfy their lower level general education requirements by completing MTA. The course requirements below must be completed with a 2.0 or higher, and at least 1 credit of MTA-coursework must be completed at Schoolcraft for the College to grant the endorsement. Occupational courses and general credit do not qualify.

What are the Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements?

Minimum Total for MTA Credit Hours	30
