

CULINARY BAKING AND PASTRY ARTS CERTIFICATE APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Prior to Program Admissions

The Culinary Baking and Pastry Arts Certificate requires an application. This program requires students to complete a specific list of requirements before being officially admitted. Students are listed in a pre-program code while the application requirements are being met. The full program start date and implementation of program code may be dependent on space availability. To be admitted to the program, the student must complete the following:

First steps: Apply to Schoolcraft College Send official transcripts (if applicable)
Meet with an Academic Advisor
Complete the following before applying: CUL 102 and successful completion of ServSafe exam OR submit proof of a valid ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certificate CBPA 103* with a 2.5+ (only offered in spring semesters) * Students who have completed CUL 136 and CUL 150 as part of the Professional Culinary Arts program will not need to complete this course. *Must be completed within five years of application
Achieve: Minimum English score OR 1.8+ high school GPA Minimum reading score OR 1.8+ high school GPA Minimum math score OR 1.8+ high school GPA Cumulative GPA of 2.0+
Finalize your admission: Meet with an Academic Advisor to finalize your acceptance into the Culinary Baking and Pastry Arts Certificate Program.
