Prior to Program Admissions

The Radiologic Technology AAS requires an application. This program requires students to complete a specific list of requirements before being officially admitted. Students are listed in a pre-program code while the application requirements are being met. The full program start date and implementation of program code may be dependent on space availability. To be admitted to the program, the student must complete the following:

First steps:

- ___ Apply to Schoolcraft College
- ___ Send official transcripts (if applicable)
- ___ Meet with an Academic Advisor

Complete the following before applying:

- ___ HIT 100 **OR** HIT 104 with a 2.0+
- ___ RAD 100 with a 3.0+
- ___ RAD 105* with a 3.0+
- ___ MATH 102 **OR** MATH 113+ with a 3.0+
- ___ BIOL 236 with a 3.0+
- ___ **OR**
- ___ BIOL 237 and 238 with a 3.0+
- ___ PHYS 123 with a 3.0+
- ___ TEAS** with minimum scores
 - Composite: 60%
 - Reading: 68%
 - English: 60%
 - Math: 60%
 - Science: 50%

***Requires completion of RAD 100, BIOL 236, and MATH with a 3.0+ and completion with a 3.0+ or co-requisite of PHYS 123**

****Must be completed at Schoolcraft. Talk to an advisor about TEAS policies.**

Achieve:

- ___ Minimum English score **OR**
2.8+ high school GPA
- ___ Minimum reading score **OR**
2.8+ high school GPA
- ___ Cumulative GPA of 2.5+

Courses required to graduate but not needed prior to application:

- ___ ENG 101
- ___ COMA 103
- ___ Social science (various options)
- ___ PHIL 257

Finalize your admission:

- ___ Meet with an Academic Advisor to finalize your acceptance into the Radiologic Technology AAS Degree.

Permit required for:

- ___ RAD 105

Before starting the program, students will need to complete a background check, physical exam, and drug screening. Students are also required to have certain vaccinations for clinical placement.
