



PROFESSIONAL CULINARY ARTS PROGRAM APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Prior to Program Admission

The Professional Culinary Arts program requires an application. This program requires students to complete a specific list of requirements before being officially admitted. Students are listed in a pre-program code while the application requirements are being met. The full program start date and implementation of program code may be dependent on space availability. To be admitted to the program, the student must complete the following:

First steps:

- Apply to Schoolcraft College
- Send official transcripts (if applicable)
- Meet with an Academic Advisor

Complete the following before applying:

- Meet with an Academic Advisor to complete a permit request for CUL 103
- CUL 102 with a 2.0+ **OR** submit proof of a valid ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certificate
- Receive permit for CUL 103
- Complete CUL 103* with a 2.5+ **OR** earn credit through an established high school articulation

**Must be completed within five years of application*

Achieve:

- Minimum English score **OR**
 - 1.8+ high school GPA
- Minimum reading score **OR**
 - 1.8+ high school GPA
- Minimum math score **OR**
 - 1.8+ high school GPA
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0+

- Meet with an Academic Advisor to finalize your acceptance into the Professional Culinary Arts program.
