



## HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AAS DEGREE APPLICATION CHECKLIST

### Prior to Program Admission

The Health Information Technology AAS Degree requires an application. This program requires students to complete a specific list of requirements before being officially admitted. Students are listed in a pre-program code while the application requirements are being met. The full program start date and implementation of program code may be dependent on space availability. To be admitted to the program, the student must complete the following:

#### First steps:

- Apply to Schoolcraft College
- Send official transcripts (if applicable)
- Meet with an Academic Advisor

#### Complete the following before applying:

- BIOL 236 with a 2.0+
- OR**
- BIOL 237 and 238 with a 2.0+
- HIT 104 with a 2.0+
- CIS 120 with a 2.0+

#### Achieve:

- Minimum English score **OR** 2.8+ high school GPA
- Minimum reading score **OR** 2.8+ high school GPA
- Minimum math score **OR** 2.8+ high school GPA
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0+

#### While working on pre-requisite classes, students can also take:

- HIT 114 with a 2.0+
- HIT 118 with a 2.0+
- HIT 120 with a 2.0+
- HIT 130 with a 2.0+
- ENG 101 with a 2.0+
- ENG 102 or ENG 106 with a 2.0+
- MATH 111 with a 2.0+
- Social science (options vary) with a 1.0+
- Humanities (options vary) with a 1.0+

#### Finalize your admission:

- Meet with an Academic Advisor to finalize your acceptance into the Health Information Technology AAS degree.

*Please note: Students must maintain a 2.0+ GPA in Health Information Technology (HIT) classes.*
