



PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAMS APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Prior to Program Admission

The Pharmacy Technician Skills Certificate and Pharmacy Technician Certificate programs require an application. This program requires students to complete a specific list of requirements before being officially admitted. Students are listed in a pre-program code while the application requirements are being met. The full program start date and implementation of program code may be dependent on space availability. To be admitted to the program, the student must complete the following:

First steps:

- Apply to Schoolcraft College
- Send official transcripts (if applicable)
- Meet with an Academic Advisor

Complete the following before applying:

- Minimum English score ***OR***
 - 1.8+ high school GPA
- Minimum reading score ***OR***
 - 1.8+ high school GPA
- Minimum math score ***OR***
 - 1.8+ high school GPA
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0+

Finalize your admission:

- Meet with an Academic Advisor to finalize your acceptance into a Pharmacy Technician Program.

Before starting the program, students will need to complete a background check, physical exam, and drug screening. Students are also required to have certain vaccinations for clinical placement.
