



SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY AAS DEGREE APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Prior to Program Admission

The Surgical Technology AAS requires an application. This program requires students to complete a specific list of requirements before being officially admitted. Students are listed in a pre-program code while the application requirements are being met. The full program start date and implementation of program code may be dependent on space availability. To be admitted to the program, the student must complete the following:

First steps:

- Apply to Schoolcraft College
- Send official transcripts (if applicable)
- Meet with an Academic Advisor

Other required courses:

- BIOL 101 with a 2.0+
- BIOL 238* with a 3.0+
- COMA 103 with a 2.0+

**BIOL 236 is not accepted for this program*

Complete the following before applying:

- Two English courses with a 2.0+ (ENG 101, 102, 221)
- HIT 100 **OR** HIT 104 with a 3.0+
- SURG 100 with a 3.0+
- SURG 101* with a 3.0+
- Social Science course with a 2.0+ (PSYCH 201, SOC 201, 205, 210, or 220)
- General education math course with a 2.0+
- PHIL 257 with a 2.0+
- BIOL 237 with a 3.0+
- BIOL 243 with a 3.0+ (BIOL 101 must be completed first)

*Certified Registered Central Service Technicians (CRCSTs) may receive prior learning credit for this course

Finalize your admission:

- Meet with an Academic Advisor to finalize your acceptance into Surgical Technology AAS Degree.

Permit required for:

- SURG 201
- SURG 202

*All SURG courses in the program must be completed with a 3.0+

Before starting the program, students will need to complete a background check, physical exam, and drug screening. Students are also required to have certain vaccinations for clinical placement.

Achieve:

- Cumulative GPA of 2.5+
