4. **BIOL 236 or (BIOL 237 and BIOL 238)** BIOL 237 is needed for application acceptance and BIOL 238 must be completed prior to the beginning of the program (see #10 below). Students who do not have BIOL 238 completed prior to Fall semester, will not be allowed to start the program. Check GPA scale from institution. There is no time limit restriction on biology credits for nursing admission.

6. **NURSING ADMISSIONS TEAS EXAM** Achieve the required minimum scores on the online (not paper/pencil) TEAS Exam (Test of Essential Academic Skills) within 4 attempts. Highest scores in each section on the exam attempts will be accepted. Maximum number of overall attempts allowed is four (4) attempts. (See page 4: Admission Exam criteria.)

Students must complete all sections of the TEAS Exam with maximum effort on each attempt. Minimum scores required are:

Composite 60% (Adjusted Individual Total Score*), 68% Reading, 60% English, 60% Math, 50% Science.

The Composite score must be 60% or higher on at least one of the exam attempts and the lowest composite score for the other attempts must be within a 55-60% range or higher.
