### Prior to Program Admissions

The Culinary and Dietary Operations Management Program requires students to complete a specific list of requirements before being officially admitted into the program. To be admitted to the program, the student must complete the following:

#### First steps:

- \_\_\_ Send official transcripts (if applicable)
- \_\_\_ Meet with an Academic Advisor

#### Complete the following before registering for coursework:

- \_\_\_ Meet with an Academic Advisor to obtain a permit to register for CUL 303
- \_\_\_ Complete an associate degree from an institution accredited by ACFEFAC at the time of graduation or ACFEFAC Credential as Sous Chef or higher or Professional Chef Experience.
- \_\_\_ Obtain Sanitation Certificate

#### Achieve:

- \_\_\_ Minimum English score **OR**  
ENG 101 or higher with a 2.0+
- \_\_\_ Minimum reading score **OR**  
COLLS 053 or higher with a 2.0+
- \_\_\_ Minimum MATH score **OR**  
MATH 053 or higher with a 2.0+
- \_\_\_ Computer Proficiency **OR**  
CIS 120 with a 2.0+
- \_\_\_ Chemistry Proficiency **OR**  
CHEM 100 with a 2.0+
- \_\_\_ Cumulative College GPA 2.0+

#### Complete CUL 303

- \_\_\_ Complete CUL 303 with a 2.5+

#### Finalize your admissions:

- \_\_\_ Meet with an Academic Advisor to finalize your acceptance into the Culinary and Dietary Operations Management program.
