6. NURSING ADMISSIONS TEAS EXAM Achieve the required minimum scores on the <u>online</u> TEAS Exam (Test of Essential Academic Skills) within two attempts per 12 months. Highest scores in each section on the two attempts will be accepted. Maximum number of overall attempts allowed is four (4) attempts. (See page 4: Admission Exam criteria.)

Students must complete all sections of the TEAS Exam with maximum effort on each attempt plus continue to meet the composite 60% with all attempts. Minimum scores required are:

Minimum Scores: Composite 60% (Adjusted Individual Total Score), 68% Reading, 60% English, 60% Math, 50% Science.
