Upon completion of CBPA 103 with a grade of 2.5 or above, and submission of a valid ServSafe Food Protection Certificate (earned within five years) you will meet with a representative from the Culinary Arts Department to complete the Culinary Baking and Pastry Arts Restricted Enrollment Program Change Form. The form will be turned in to the Academic Advising Office who will officially admit you to the Culinary Arts Baking and Pastry Arts Program.
